

# Proposal Request for Port of Pascagoula Strategic Development Plan

The Port of Pascagoula is soliciting proposals from interested firms to provide the port with professional services to complete a comprehensive Strategic Development Plan. The following information provides minimum deliverables, terms and conditions, evaluation criteria, submittal requirements, and a tentative process schedule. We encourage firms to demonstrate creativity and provide their best approach to delivering a strategic facility plan. This plan should include the following areas: West Bank Harbor, East Bank Harbor, Singing River Island, and the International Paper Site.

### Port of Pascagoula's Organizational Goals:

- 1. Develop a port infrastructure plan that modernizes the port while focusing on the diversity of cargo
- 2. Increase Port Competitiveness among Gulf Coast Ports
- 3. Serve as Economic Engine for Region
- 4. Promote Workforce Development and Diversity
- 5. Expand Green Port and Technology Initiatives
- 6. Increase Cargo Growth

**Plan Objectives:** Creation of a 5 and 10-year Strategic Development Plan, with various-year benchmarks, for capital improvements encompassing new facilities, renovation, expansion, redevelopment, or repurposing of existing facilities; and a Terminal Development Plan for sequential growth by identifying needs, creating a critical path to achievement delineated by a prioritized project list with timeline and funding, aligned with organizational goals.

#### Minimum Deliverables

- 1. Develop a plan to support and enhance the Port of Pascagoula's mission and goals and review and update it as needed.
- 2. Complete market-based cargo and demand forecast: high, medium, and low cargo forecasts by direction of trade (import/export) and in five-year increments over a 10-year horizon.
- 3. Perform capacity assessment for each terminal, road, and rail connection, identify enhancement opportunities, and recommend improvements to facilitate the transportation of goods from the port to the end user.
- 4. Meet with terminal operators and other Port stakeholders in individual and group settings to understand their infrastructure needs for future port development.
- 5. Provide prioritized existing facility capital development, redevelopment, and expansion projects with cost estimates and timelines (in 5-year increments).
- 6. Provide Final Plan Deliverable, including all data, analysis, and graphical representation in both paper and electronic formats.

# Other Terms and Conditions:

- This is intended to be awarded as a Not-to-exceed task order under a professional services contract.
  Progress reports will be required to accompany invoicing for payment on percentage completion of
  respective interim deliverables.
- 2. Identify and provide interim deliverables on the work plan (schedule of values or percentage effort, rough and prefinal drafts of deliverable documents.)
- 3. Target completion of all tasks three months from issuance of Task Order.



- 4. The plan should be a usable document capable of being updated, meaning it will be delivered in a format that can be easily adapted and revised in response to unexpected changes and events occurring over the next 10 years.
- 5. Any proprietary software licenses needed to utilize the electronic format of the deliverable described above shall be included as part of that deliverable component(s).
- 6. Offerors can provide alternative approaches and/or consultants for cargo and demand forecasts.

### **Completed Relevant Studies**

The Port of Pascagoula will make all relevant past plans and studies available to the three short-listed firms before interviews via a shared file site to avoid replicating past/existing planning efforts.

# **Scoring/Selection Criteria**

Port of Pascagoula will use the following criteria (not in order of priority) in evaluating each submission:

- 1. Qualifications, skills, and applicable experience of the principals and team members
- 2. Experience managing projects of similar size, scope, and complexity.
- 3. Ability to perform the work within the schedule, evidenced by sufficient qualified staff
- 4. The ability to demonstrate a clear understanding of the objectives of this project
- 5. Overall strength of proposal approach and methodology
